START DATES

SESSION START DATES

Greystone College has ongoing monthly or bimonthly session start dates depending on the schedule. Each session marks the start of a new course or set of courses. Our program start dates align with session start dates and programs follow one of two systems:

Flexible Ongoing Sessional Entry: In most of our programs, courses run in an ongoing, repeated sequence and students may enter the program on any session start date. In these programs, each course offers learning content that stands alone, and is not a pre-requisite to any other course in the program. Shorter certificates and single classes run on limited specific start dates.

Set Entry: Some programs are progressive meaning they begin with foundational learning at the start of the program and students continue to build upon their knowledge with each progressive course. To support student success, these programs are offered on limited set start dates.

GREYSTONE MONTREAL ONLY, besides all the above:

- CAQ Application is required before applying for study permit
- Student must have completed high school at least 8 months before intended to start at Greystone Montreal
- Student is ready to start the program

*Applicable for Greystone College Toronto only: Student has the option to take the Wonderlic Test on the first day of classes, but is recommended to take the test before registering.

Students are expected to have a computer or tablet that enables them to connect to the Internet in order to review material and submit assessments.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to any Greystone College program, prospective students must meet specific requirements regarding prior education, English language proficiency and minimum age, where applicable.

All applicants must submit, with their application, academic records and other documents deemed necessary for admission purposes.

Admission Requirements vary by location.

PAYMENT PLAN

GENERAL RULES

- Available for Greystone programs with a minimum of 6 months academic study duration (not including co-op)
- Up to 4 installments (varies according to program length)
- Registration fee deposit will be charged at the time of registration as part of the first installment
- Agent should request an installment plan at the time of registration
- An installment fee of \$100 will be applied
- Commission will be paid out after each installment
- All add-ons (insurance, accommodation, custodianship letter, etc.) must be paid within the first installment

PAYMENT PLAN OPTIONS

Depending on the length of the program, students may pay in up to 4 payments*

- Programs of 26 academic study weeks duration or longer can be paid in 2 installments
- Programs of 48 academic study weeks duration or longer can be paid in 3 installments
- Programs of 72 academic study weeks duration or longer can be paid in 4 installments

First Payment Includes: Full registration fee, full installment plan fee, full textbook/materials fees, the first tuition installment fee (50%, 33.34% or 25% of the total tuition fee, depending on program length), plus other fees in full related to homestay, insurance, airport pick-up, etc.

Subsequent Payments (each payment):

- 2 installment plans: 50% of total tuition fee
- 3 installment plans: 33.33% of total tuition fee
- 4 installment plans: 25% of the total tuition fee

DUE DATES

A tailored payment plan including specific due dates will be provided to students (or their agents) depending on their program and the selected number of installments.

For co-op students, the final installment will be due 8 weeks prior to the start of the co-op term.
