- Students who register for the March 23, 2026 start date with a 40% scholarship but later postpone their start date for personal reasons may have their tuition adjusted to the 30% scholarship rate. However, if the postponement is due to visa delays or other circumstances beyond the student's control, Greystone Institute will honour the original scholarship.

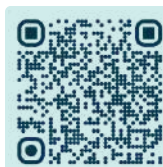
